Antipodes Theatre Company seeks to provide a collaborative and inclusive environment for producing independent theatre in Melbourne.

Programming includes: full-length plays and musicals, cabarets, live events, year-round workshops for artists, and supporting new work and local writers through our Winter Lab, Ricochet Reading Series and ongoing development initiatives.

Our aim is to produce challenging and enlightening work that embraces duality within the human condition. Work that looks at situations from a unique angle or exposes what it is like to step into someone else's shoes. Antipodes was founded, in part, by New York City transplants who currently find themselves as close to the antipode of that location as they are ever likely to be.

Finally, Antipodes strives to maintain an inclusive and safe work space through a minimum of 50% representation – on stage and off – by women, ethnically diverse artists, people with disability, trans and non-binary people, seniors, or other members of historically or culturally marginalised communities who are not well represented on stage.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Dave Malloy wrote much of Ghost Quartet in the apartments of the four original cast members: Brent Arnold, Brittain Ashford, Gelsey Bell and Malloy himself. Four musicians in a room drinking whisky and experimenting with how to tell their version of stories that have existed for centuries. Malloy's fascination with the question "Why do we believe in ghosts?" extends not only to the stories that shape us, but also the stories we choose to tell; whether in classics (like Arabian Nights or Grimm's Fairy Tales) or when The New York Post published a photo on their front page showing a man who had fallen onto the subway tracks and was about to be killed by an oncoming train.

Through Malloy's unique perspective, we are allowed a glimpse into the messy, chaotic, but also deeply felt mindset of someone grappling with death, grief, and guilt: the struggle with whether to believe in an afterlife, the inevitable longing and loss experienced by trying to connect with those who have passed on, and the nagging feeling that maybe we aren't living our lives to their fullest potential. Ghost Quartet is written as a song cycle, inspired by concept albums like Pink Floyd's The Wall and David Bowie's Ziggy Stardust, which allows the piece to harness the full potential that music has to express complex emotions through a series of shifting genres and styles. It is also a celebration of the communal storytelling experience, like those we experience around a campfire or reading bedtime stories at night.

We are so thrilled to revisit this piece, our inaugural production, and are honoured to welcome Melbourne audiences back to the theatre.

GHOST QUARTET IS A SHOW ABOUT LOVE, DEATH AND WHISKEY

A camera breaks and four musicians drink as they unravel four interwoven narratives spanning seven centuries: a warped fairy tale about two sisters, a treehouse astronomer and a lazy evil bear; a retelling of Edgar Allan Poe's The Fall of the House of Usher; a purgatorial intermezzo about Scheherazade and the ghost of Thelonious Monk; and a contemporary fable about a subway murder.

Inspired by source material as diverse as Arabian Nights and the television series The Twilight Zone, Ghost Quartet is spirited modern musical where nothing is as it seems.

Ghost Quartet first premiered in 2014 at the Bushwick Starr and originally starred Brent Arnold, Brittain Ashford, Gelsey Bell and Dave Malloy. The show has since toured and has been performed across America and also in Scotland for Edinburgh Fringe Festival.

ASHLEIGH WALWYN SHE/HER


STAGE MANAGER
